The ideal candidate(s) will have a Diploma in Child and Youth Care or other relevant field combined with experience implementing treatment with at-risk youth, as well as working with youth in recreational programs. Experience in a residential youth setting would be an asset. Equal consideration will be given to those candidates who have an equivalent combination of experience and post-secondary coursework towards a relevant degree or diploma. Candidates possessing sufficient education but who have limited relevant experience may be considered for an appointment on an underfill basis.

This is an on-going competition with no closing date. Auxiliary on call employees fill in for absences due to illness, vacation, peak work periods, etc. There is no guarantee of work hours.
